**Assignment Title: Consultancy services for design and detailed engineering and ESIA and procurement support for a pumping station at Uitkijk, Saramacca.**

The Republic of Suriname has received a loan from the World Bank towards the Saramacca Canal System Rehabilitation Project, and and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Design and detailed engineering, Environmental and Social studies, Bidding documents and Procurement support of a pumping station at Uitkijk, Saramacca.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include among others:

- Finalize the set of boundary conditions based on the results of the Saramacca Canal System Project Drainage Masterplan 2024.
- Execute all the required surveys at and around the site for technical, environmental and social impact assessments.
- Prepare detailed designs and bidding documents for the pump station including all necessary elements (pump house, pump units, inlet and outlet channels, piping layouts, bed and bank protection measures etc.).
- Prepare all necessary environmental- and social documentation for construction of the pump station, including the development of an ESIA.
- Provide support to the bidding, award and contract negotiation process of the works.

The Ministry of Public Works (MPW) now invites eligible Consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultancy firms can submit a written application to the Ministry of Public Works on the address below.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” July 2016 and updated in November 2017 and August 2018 (“Procurement Regulations”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

The Consultancy firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection Method set out in the Procurement Regulations. The Consultancy firm is responsible for meeting all tax liabilities, transportation cost arising out of the contract unless stated otherwise. For national consultancy firms payment will be in Surinamese Dollars (SRD).

Consultant firms may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

Applications can be delivered in hard or soft copy to the address below during business days, or by email by July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025 till 14:00 Suriname time.

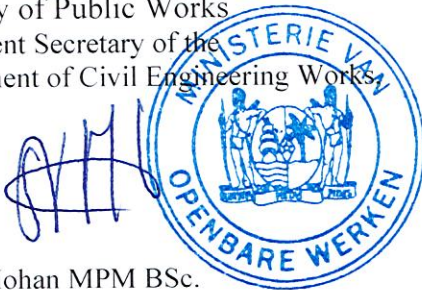
