The Republic of Suriname has received a loan from the World Bank towards the Saramacca Canal System Rehabilitation Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Consulting Services for the preparation of Detailed Designs, Bidding Documents, Environmental & Social Assessment, and Construction Supervision for Drainage improvement and flood control measures in Paramaribo Center and Winti Wai.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include among others:

- (a) prepare Detailed Designs of interventions in secondary and tertiary drainage components in Paramaribo Centrum and Winti Wai, following pilot studies (Concept design stage) on these works prepared as output of the World Bank-financed Saramacca Canal System Rehabilitation Project,
- (b) develop the Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) and the Environmental and Social Management Plan (ESMP) in accordance with GoS guidelines and World Bank requirements,
- (c) support the S-PMU in the engagement/communication with the stakeholders, which may involve providing recommendations related to innovative mechanisms for the use of private land for drainage works,
- (d) prepare Bidding Documents in accordance with the World Bank’s Standard Procurement Documents for the selected contract package(s) of works and support the S-PMU with technical inputs to the subsequent bid evaluation and contract finalization,
- (e) provide Knowledge Transfer and Capacity Building related to the assignment, and
- (f) subsequently Supervise Construction.

The Ministry of Public Works (MPW) now invites eligible Consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultancy firms can submit a written application to the Ministry of Public Works on the address below.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” (Sixth Edition, February 2025) (“Procurement Regulations”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

The Consultancy firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection Method set out in the Procurement Regulations. The Consultancy firm is responsible for meeting all tax liabilities, transportation cost arising out of the contract unless stated otherwise. For national consultancy firms payment will be in Surinamese Dollars (SRD).

Consultant firms may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
